B013 ALOA PRP Exam Prep

This is not a beginning locksmith class. The class is designed as a review for locksmiths who have hands on field experience, but have not taken or passed the L-00 Mandatory exam of the ALOA Proficiency Registration Program. The class will consist of a lecture and power point review of the ten basic locksmithing topics (Key Origination by Code and Code Equipment; Pin and Disc Cylinder Servicing; Key Blank Identification; Key Duplication Techniques and Equipment; Key Origination by Impressioning; Professional Lock Opening Techniques; Lockset Servicing; Lockset Functions and Finishes; Basic Master Keying; Cabinet, Furniture and Mailbox Locks) that are incorporated into the L-00 exam.

You will also learn: tips to help you approach the exam in the proper frame of mind; techniques to ease your test taking fears; how to read written exam questions to best determine what is being asked; and how to select the correct answer in a multiple choice exam. If you are a locksmith who has gained your knowledge either from hands-on field experience or on the job training, this class will provide the tools that you need for being successful in certification exam preparation. The ALOA Resource Guide will be the class text.

Note: A \$20 fee is required to cover the cost of the ALOA PRP Resource Guide.

The information presented will be useful in preparing for PRP section L-00. Students who take the course and are ALOA members may take the L-00 PRP exam during the final 3 hours of the class for an additional \$25.00 this option is not available to non-members..

There will also be a full PRP Exam conducted at the same time. A separate form is required to register directly with ALOA for the full PRP Exam.
