

Alabama Locksmith Association Scholarship Program

ALA Scholarship Guidelines and Application

This Scholarship is for Beginner Locksmith Certification Class, Book and Beginner exam.

This scholarship does **NOT** include hotel, food or transportation.

This scholarship is open to Alabama Licensed Locksmiths companies that is in good standings with Alabama Locksmith Association by being a member.

The applicant sponsor (Locksmith company) may submit an application for an employee (helper) that is registered with the AESBL as a helper for your company.

The winner will be placed in a beginner class, offered by Alabama locksmith Association. Alabama Locksmith Association has the discretion as to which class.

The sponsor and sponsor's employee must completely fill out the application in full for application to be accepted.

All sponsor companies must have a Licensed locksmith business in the state of Alabama.

All applicant (helper) must reside in the state of Alabama and be employed by a Licensed Locksmith Company and have a locksmith helper license through the AESBL.

The winner must pass an exam for beginner class: if the winner does not pass the first exam a second test date will be given within 60 days of the first exam. If winner cannot pass exam the second time, the sponsor will be liable to pay ½ of tuition cost to Alabama Locksmith Association.

The winner has 3 months from date of completion of class to get a Locksmith License through the State of Alabama AESBL, or the sponsor will be asked to pay the tuition of the beginner class.

All applications will be collected and given to Alabama Locksmith Association Board. All applications will be discussed, and one winner will be decided by the board of Alabama Locksmith Association.

No board member or affiliated personnel will be eligible for scholarship.

The association will open the scholarship program the 1st of January every year. The Application process will close the last Friday in March. The winner will be announced at the Locksmith Trade Show in April. I agree and understand the rules and regulation of the Alabama Locksmith Association Scholarship
